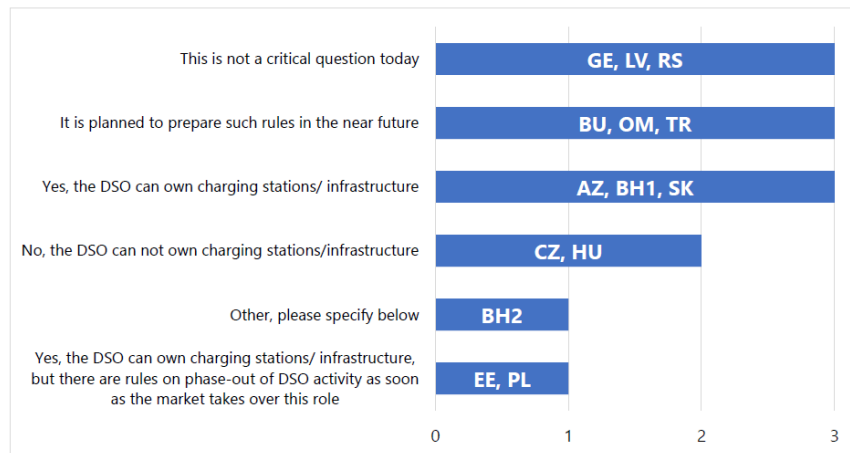

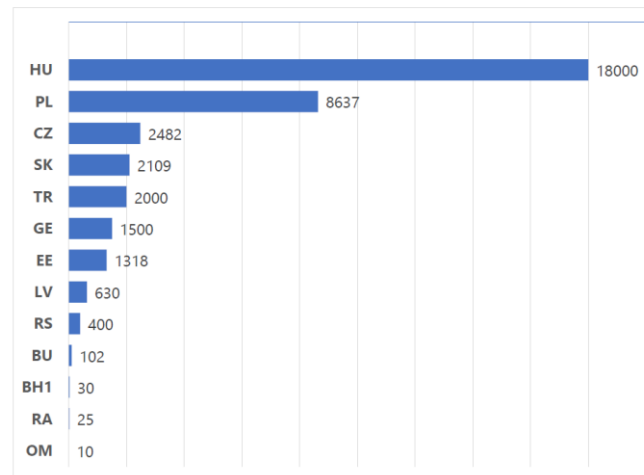

## 1.2. Does the market model (set by the legal/regulatory framework) allow or disallow utility (DSO) ownership of charging stations/infrastructure?

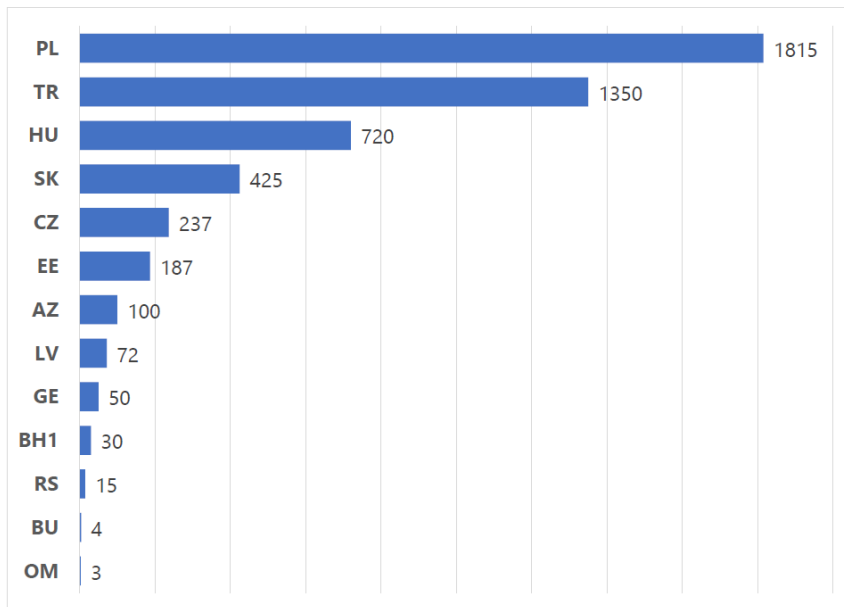

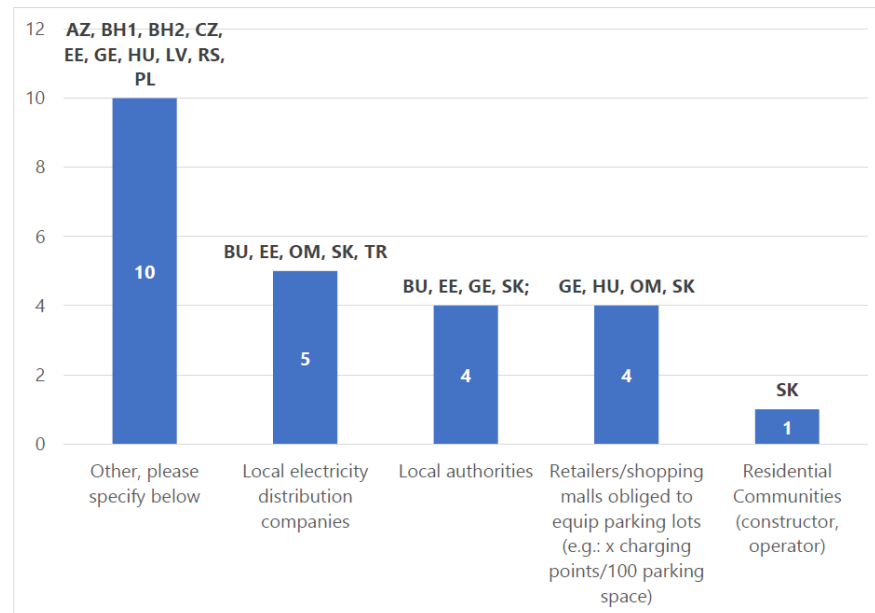
