

19 July–1 August 2022

Public consultation (methodology for calculating tariffs for electricity transmission system services)

12 August 2022

Consensus meeting after public consultation

September 2022

Decision of the tariff methodology

25 October 2022

Explanation of all the upcoming changes

3–17 November 2022

Public consultation (methodology for calculating tariffs for electricity distribution system services)

8 December 2022

Public hearing about the electricity distribution tariff

CASE STUDY: ELECTRICITY DISTRIBUTION AND TRANSMISSION TARIFFS (2/3)



23 November 2022

Consensus meeting after public consultation about electricity distribution tariff

December 2022

The decision to increase tariffs was approved by Parliament

26 April 2023

Press conference together with both merchants



24 May 2023

Announcement about the new tariffs

7 August 2023



WHAT DID WE DO?

- Direct engagement with political decision-makers, ministries, and Parliament
- Prime-time interviews on public media
- Informal media breakfast

LESSONS LEARNED

Don't take anything for granted

If you want the message to be heard, put it on repeat at a high volume

Be more proactive; it doesn't matter if other stakeholders are on stage, there is enough space in the public information room

The band leader should be on stage from the first moment of the gig

Comprehensive communication is the key
