



Licensing and certification procedure in the gas market

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Legal framework



- 1. The aspects of licensing and certification of enterprises operating in the natural gas sector are covered in the Law on natural gas nr.108/2016.
 - Main type of activities in the natural gas sector which require a license;
 - General principles for licensing activities in the natural gas sector;
 - General requirements for obtaining licenses;
 - Aspects concerning the public service obligations of enterprises in the sector;
 - The sphere of activity for the natural gas sector participants, and special conditions for externalizing certain activities by the license holders;
 - Rights and obligations of the license holders;
 - Conditions for the suspension, withdrawal and extension of licenses.

License issuance requirements



- 1. Licenses for the **supply of natural gas** are granted to <u>natural persons or legal</u> <u>entities registered the Republic of Moldova</u>, while activities such as **production**, **transport**, **distribution and storage** <u>are granted exclusively to legal entities</u>;
- 2. Every particular set of licensed activities has certain **minimum requirements** the requesting party has to meet in order to be issued a license (e.g.: qualified personnel, necessary financial capital, an administrator with a clean legal record with documental proof);
- 3. Licenses for activities such as <u>supply</u>, <u>production</u>, <u>transmission</u>, <u>distribution</u> and <u>storage</u> of natural gas are granted for a **period of 25 years**;
- 4. Licenses for activities involving the <u>supply of compressed natural gas</u> for vehicle fueling stations are granted for a **period of 10 years**;
- 5. The issuance cost for one license is approximately 160 euros.

Licensing procedure



- 1. The request form and the necessary documents are submitted to ANRE, which then registers it;
 - The procedure can be done online with the use of a digital signature.
- 2. The Agency then examines the attached dossier and informs the requesting party about any additional documents that need to be provided;
 - The examination procedure term is suspended and resumed after the documents are presented.
- 3. The Agency issues the license to the requesting party within 15 days of the submission of the request.
 - The request is considered registered after the payment of the license fee by the requesting party.
- 4. A license holder may request the extension for the term of the license in electronic form, and by paying the appropriate license fee.

Other legal requirements and mentions



- 1. Overall the principles and aspects of licensing, authorizing and certifying various types of regulated activates are governed by a separate Law on the regulation of the entrepreneurial activity nr.160/2011.
- 2. ANRE also developed Regulation nr.445/2021 on the issuance, extension, renewal and withdrawal of authorizations for closed looped natural gas distribution system operators.
- 3. In order to facilitate and provide a more cohesive and unified procedure to obtain a license, all requests submitted by interested parties are processed through a unified governmental services portal (**eGov.md**).
