



Update about price trends in Poland

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Price trends in 2022

- Prices of gas have been frozen for the whole 2022 for households and public utility entities enumerated in Energy Law Act

(housing cooperatives, similar entities purchasing gas for consumption by households, medical facilities, public health care units, social care units, educational institutions, churches and religious communities, cultural institutions, NGOs).

Range of entities covered by tariffs as well as the deadline of tariff termination have been extended

- The price of gas for protected customers for 2022 is **200,17 PLN/MWh (42,49 EUR/MWh)**
- Current price for non-protected customers is **760-794 PLN/MWh (161,31-168,53 EUR/MWh)**

/example from business price list of specific gas trading company/

- Gas companies receive compensations due to selling gas to protected customers
- In 2022 **VAT** for gas was temporarily reduced **from 23% to 8%** in January and **0%** from February.

VAT reduction is applied to all customers and is introduced in steps

- Protection mechanism for 2023 has not been adopted yet.
