# SUMMER SCHOOL: INTRODUCTION TO ENERGY REGULATION

### **Regulation of Energy Storage – Online Training**

- how to structure regulation for energy storage across different power markets.
- It covers energy storage in its multiple forms, with a technology-neutral approach when it comes to regulatory recommendations around storage.
- understanding of energy storage technologies both at utility and residential levels, and with the ability to consequently define regulatory measures that ensure energy storage in its multiple forms can be deployed in the power market, and benefit consumers across multiple dimensions, at either wholesale power market level, or at the level of ancillary services to the power grid.
