Summer School: June 19-23



After attending the ERRA Summer School you will return back to work with:

- the **role of regulators** and familiarity with the **theory and institutions of regulation**
- advantages and disadvantages of the various wholesale market design
- principles of **calculating prices and tariffs** in the energy sector
- **regulatory roles** in increasing competition levels in wholesale energy markets
- the **value chain, market structure** and **regulation of natural gas markets** – including LNG markets
- challenges of **integrating renewable energy**, including **PPAs** and auction designs
- understanding impacts of the **energy transition** on energy regulators
- introduction to **grid development and grid management**

Regulation of Energy Storage – Online Training

The course aims to provide participants with the necessary understanding on:

- **how to structure regulation for energy storage across different power markets.**
- It covers energy storage in its multiple forms, **with a technology-neutral approach** when it comes to regulatory recommendations around storage.
- It provides participants with the necessary understanding of energy storage technologies **both at utility and residential levels**, and with the ability to consequently define regulatory measures that ensure energy storage in its multiple forms can be deployed in the power market, and **benefit consumers across multiple dimensions**, at either **wholesale power market level, or at the level of ancillary services** to the power grid.



Regulation of Energy Storage – Online Training



The course is dedicated to the **core responsibilities and activities of water utility regulatory authorities**. Participants will gain knowledge on **key economic concepts guiding the operation of the sector**, the challenges faced by sector participants including the **wider problems of water management**, and the **role of the regulator and regulatory models** including best practices. A core theme of the course is **tariff setting and approval by the regulator**: theoretical lessons will be supplemented by case study examples and a tariff setting exercise. Sufficient time will also be dedicated to the **role of performance benchmarking in regulation**.

ERRA Regulatory Research Award Paper



The purpose of the ERRA REGULATORY RESEARCH AWARD is to present the latest research in the energy sector, particularly related to energy regulation and development of energy markets and reflecting on the most up-to-date topics in the industry.

The Candidates may choose from among the following topics:

- 1) *Tariff design for demand-side flexibility*
- 2) *Consumption rebound from low-cost renewables and effects on energy efficiency targets*
- 3) *Energy-only markets and regulatory lessons from the recent energy crisis*
- 4) *Cost of financing, supply chain disruptions and impacts on RES auction prices*
- 5) *Policy considerations and methodologies in setting a maximum strike price*
- 6) *From ducks to cliffs: reserve requirements and lessons for regulators*
