Policy Level

- What are the main incentives and what sectors do they address? –A draft implementation has been prepared to address hydrogen economy development measures in all sectors in Georgia.
- Are there any targets set to achieve in the nearest future? Currently, there are no set targets for the nearest future, indicating that Georgia is in the early stages of planning.
- Please list the responsible institutions The Ministry of Economy and Sustainable Development (MOESD) is the primary governmental body overseeing hydrogen economy development. In 2022, the MOESD established a committee dedicated to supporting the development of hydrogen energy.

Regulatory Level



- Are there any plans to develop the Hydrogen Market and/or the Regulatory Framework? Georgia has an obligation to transpose Directive EU2018/2001, adapted by the Ministerial Council Decision 2021/14/MC-EnC. According to the directive, the contracting party is required to issue Guarantee of Origin (GO) for green hydrogen.
- What has been the level of exposure of the regulator towards hydrogen? GNERC has demonstrated its commitment to hydrogen development by having a representative in the hydrogen committee.
