Key developments 2022



➤ Infrastructure

- Transmission system length (km) : 23 716
- Distribution system length (km) : 150 336

➤ Gas Customer : 7 308 462

LP : 7 300 035 MP : 8 173 HP : 254

➤ Gas demand : 503 970 GWh

- Residential : 163 595 GWh
- Industrial : 111 847 GWh
- Power generation : 228 528 GWh

Security of supply

➤ *Winter 2022/23 Outlook*

Gas demand	Max gas demand	Gas system monitoring
251 490 GWh	January 62 076 GWh	The operation of the gas transmission and distribution system was under favourable conditions, with availability of gas capacity for all users.

➤ *Winter 2023/24 Outlook*

- The winter forecast shows that the monitoring of the gas system will be handled in good conditions without any distribution or interruption of gas supply for all customer.

Domestic gas news

- CREG is legally responsible for the annual forecast of gas demand for the national market for a ten-year period. The 2024-2033 program was approved by the Minister of Energy and published in November 2023.
