

Energy Balance of Georgia

In Georgia NATURAL GAS remains the Main source of satisfying the final demand for energy.

According to the energy balance of Georgia the share of natural gas in total energy consumption is increasing every year, for today it is 39%.

The reason for this can be active gasification and replacement of solid fuel with natural gas.

Natural Gas Sources in Georgia

More than 99% of Georgia's natural gas demand is met by imports and the remaining small part by domestic production.

The major part of natural gas in Georgia is imported from Azerbaijan. Over the past year, through contract Georgia has received an average of 80% of its natural gas demand from the Republic of Azerbaijan.






Total consumption of natural gas

In 2023 the demand for natural gas in the country changed a little, decreased -1% and amounted to 2,966 million cubic meters Consumption of natural gas:

- For household purposes amounted to 1,341 million m³
- For non-domestic purposes was equal to -1,625 million m³







2023 statistics

Demand for natural gas in Georgia 2,966 million cubic meters (-1%)




The consumption of household consumers is increasing and in 2023 it amounted to 1,341 million cubic meters (9%)

The consumption of gas stations amounted to 174 million cubic meters (-10%)



The consumption of heating plants amounted to 766 million cubic meters (1%)



Licensees in the natural gas sector

Transportation licensee - The Commission has issued the only one natural gas transportation license to the **Georgian Gas Transportation Company LLC**, which transports natural gas throughout the whole territory of Georgia.
