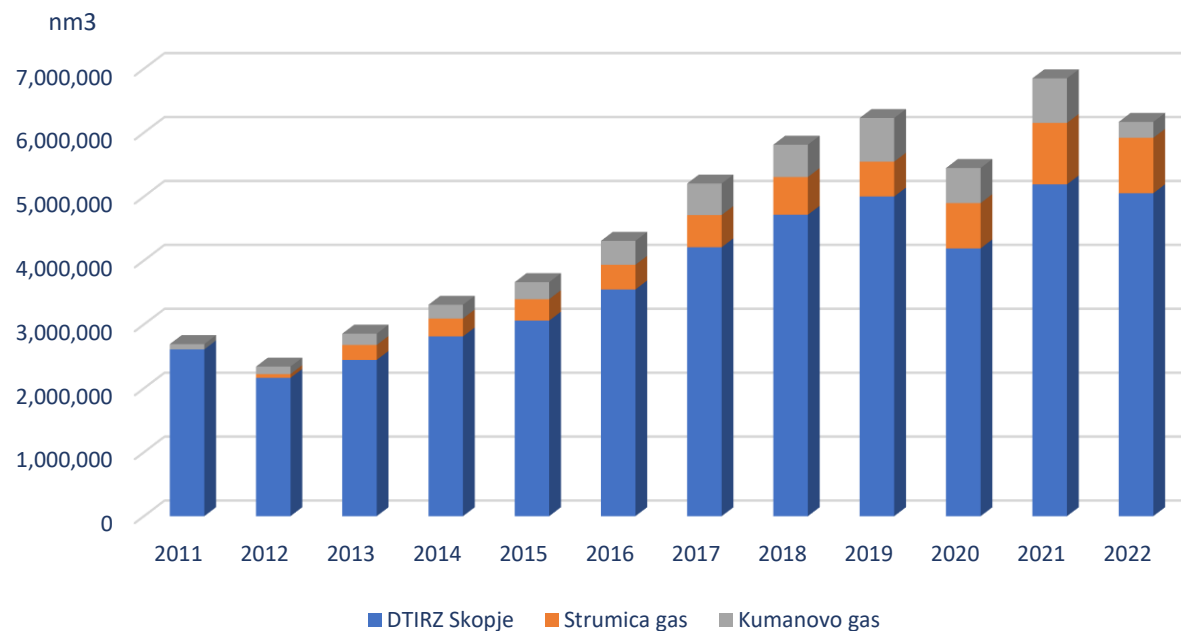

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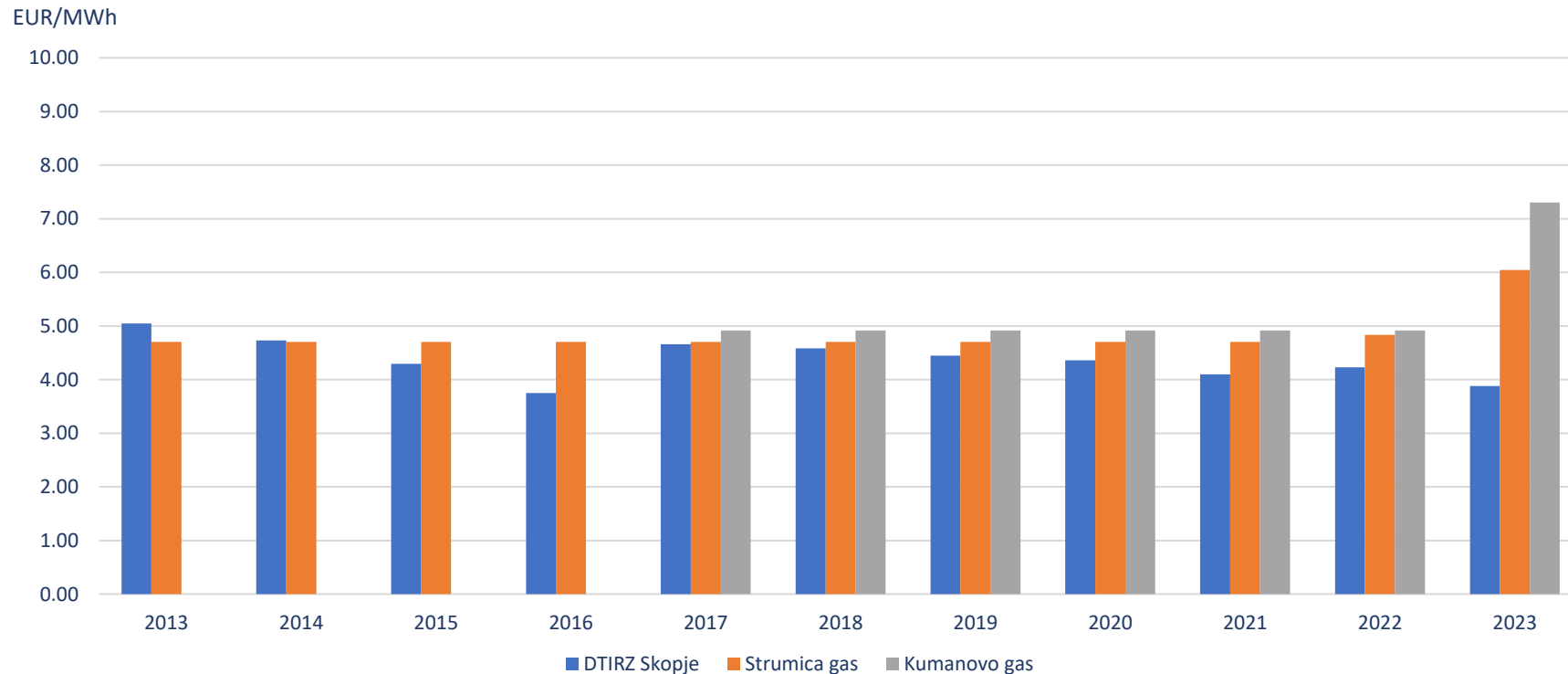

Basic data on the distribution networks

- Total of 3 small distribution networks,
 - Kumanovo gas
 - DTIRZ, Industrial zone
 - Strumica gas, isolated
- Number of connected consumers
- Public tender for distribution whole territory of the country on the way



Historical data on DSO's tariffs



DTIRZ Skopje is with the longest period in history data revealing gradual reduction of the tariff.

JP Kumanovo Gas and JP Strumica Gas, the tariff is almost fixed considering the

relatively low quantities distributed through these systems, with an increase after the last decision on natural gas prices.

- *For the DSO the method for allocating allowed revenues to customer categories is described in the Tariff methodology for the DSO*
- *At the moment all the consumers on DSO have the same tariff*
- *According to the Tariff methodology for distribution there is a possibility to introduce different tariffs for distribution for the following categories:*
 - *CHP*
 - *Heat plants*
 - *Households*
 - *Others*
