

GENERAL INFORMATION

VISA AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Every person entering Thailand must possess a valid passport or internationally recognized travel document valid. The document shall be valid for more than six (6) months from the date of entry into Thailand.

Visa is not required for a stay of less than thirty (30) days for ASEAN member countries except Myanmar and Cambodia which visa is not required for a stay of less than fourteen (14) days.

BANGKOK A COSMOPOLITAN CITY

Located on the banks of the Chao Phraya River, the bustling metropolis of Bangkok has continually welcomed visitors from all corners of the world and enthralled them with its ageold Oriental culture and mystique blended with present-day modernity. Consequently, this metropolis of diversity that is the hub of Thai society is able to cater to all interests and provide them with the opportunity to experience the element of unique "Thainess", a sense of style found nowhere else in the world awaiting to engulf visitors.

Bangkok was designated as "World's Most Visited City" in 2023 according to the MasterCard Global Destinations Cities Index. It never fails to impress delegates with state-of-the-art meeting venues and exceptional hotel facilities along with breathtaking sightseeing and the attractions of a unique cultural heritage. With countless delights such as the vibrant nightlife, eclectic street markets, world-class shopping centers, live boxing and much more, the city won the "Best Leisure Destination in Asia-Pacific" award in 2022 by Business Traveler Magazine for the sixth consecutive time.



CLIMATE

Bangkok has a tropical monsoonal climate with high humidity, but it is located outside the typhoon belt. Most of the country experiences three seasons, the cool season from November to January, the hot season from February to April and the rainy season from May to October. The average rainfall (mostly in the form of heavy showers in the rainy season) is 142 centimeters and the annual mean temperature is 28 degrees Celsius, ranging from a night minimum of 20 degrees Celsius in the cool season to a maximum day temperature of 38-45 degrees Celsius in the hot season. With the high humidity the weather can be oppressive, but the widespread use of air-conditioners alleviates the heat and humidity.



THAI CUISINE

Thai cuisine is justifiably world famous. It is a subtle and complex blend of Chinese, Indian, Malay and Polynesian influences. Seasoned with garlic, ginger and chilies, it mixes lime juice, lemon grass, fresh coriander, basil, galanga root, tamarind juice, ground peanuts and coconut milk. Dishes range from pungent curries, spicy salads, barbecued meat and seafood to mild noodle dishes that can be made spicy by adding different sauces.

TELE-COMMUNICATION

You can buy a Thai SIM card anywhere in Thailand but it is best to purchase it right at the airport and get connected right away. In most of Thailand's international airports you will see the shops of all 3 Thai mobile phone service providers just after passing the customs area. You can buy a SIM card there and the staff will help you to set up your phone.
