Prepared by **Mikheil Odisharia** (ERRA Secretariat), the paper draws on hands-on regulatory experience across European Union and Energy Community jurisdictions. The analysis explores:

- ⚡ how prosumer incentives evolve at scale
- ⚡ impacts on distribution networks and hosting capacity
- ⚡ Why regulators are phasing out volumetric netting
- ⚡ The move toward market-based remuneration aligned with EU and Energy Community principles

The findings emphasize why net billing is increasingly regarded as a more resilient and system-compatible framework for contemporary retail electricity markets.


